Key Vocabulary

Key Facts:

- Know how to count to 20 in Spanish
- Ask someone how they are feeling and give an appropriate response back
- Ask someone their name, age, where they live and give an appropriate response back.
- Have a simple conversation in Spanish
- Understand adjectival agreement

Possible activities:

- Word level activities to learn spellings, for example crosswords and word searches
- Phrase level activities to learn phrases, for example reading and matching activities
- Speaking exercises to practise speaking in Spanish
- Using picture prompt cards to assist in holding a conversation with someone in Spanish
- Listening activities for example, choosing a picture to show how someone says they are

- 1-10 in Spanish
- What a verb is in English
- Common Spanish verbs, e.g. soy (I am), tengo (I have) and vivo (I live).
