## Key Facts:

- Know the names of common classroom objects
- Learn how to use the negative
- Describe what we do and do not have in our pencil cases
- Respond to simple classroom commands

## Possible activities:

- Word level activities to learn spellings, for example crosswords and word searches
- Gap fill and matching exercises to help retention
- Reading and listening exercises to be exposed to unknown language and to practise picking out target language
- Interview other children to practise speaking and asking what items they have in their pencil case
- Class survey to see what others have in their pencil case
- Extended piece of writing to demonstrate the language they have learnt.

- What a noun/determiner is in English
- What a verb is in English
