- Count to 100 in Spanish

- Extended writing piece to say who is in my family—their names, ages and relationships to me.

- Vocabulary from "Me Presento" e.g. how to say your name and where you live
- What a verb is in English and be already familiar with the Spanish high frequency verbs in first person singular form soy (I am), tengo (I have), vivo (I live) and me llamo (I am called)
