RS1 - Environment

Learning points:

- Understand all the good things we gain from our local environment: nature connectedness, wildlife, food, space to play.
- Understand the impact of humans on the local environment including: littering, air pollution, property development.
- Discuss ways to positively impact the local environment for ourselves and the future (litter picking, recycling, walking to school, looking after things so they last, upcycling etc.)
- Understand the impact of poor environmental management on local wildlife.
- Understand reasons why people would like to help the local environment.
