Key Facts:

- Our world is an amazing place, no other known planet has life. The conditions on Earth are perfect for life to thrive.
- The world is divided into 7 continents and 5 oceans
- The North Pole is the northernmost point of the Earth. There is no land there, only ice.
- The South Pole is the southernmost place on Earth. It is located on land and is topped with solid ice. It is much colder than the North Pole.
- Europe The UK is part of Europe along with 50 other countries . Most countries use the Euro as currency.
- Asia The largest continent. Half of the world's population live here (over 4 billion).
- Australasia The smallest continent, consists of only 14 countries.
- Africa Second largest continent. Home to the largest desert (the Sahara). Lies on the equator so gets the most amount of direct sunlight.
- North America largest counties are the USA, Canada and Mexico. Home of some of the largest technology companies
- South America Home to the Amazon which spreads across 9 countries. Brazil is the largest country.
- Antarctica The highest, driest, windiest, emptiest, coldest place in the world.
