- Make simple models which express their ideas


Possible Experiences and Key Skills:

- Explore natural materials such as twigs, leaves, grass, feathers, wool, and clay.
- Collect, sort, and choose suitable items for building a nest.
- Experiment and practise with ways to arrange, weave, and layer materials.
- Investigate how to balance and join materials so the nest holds together.
