

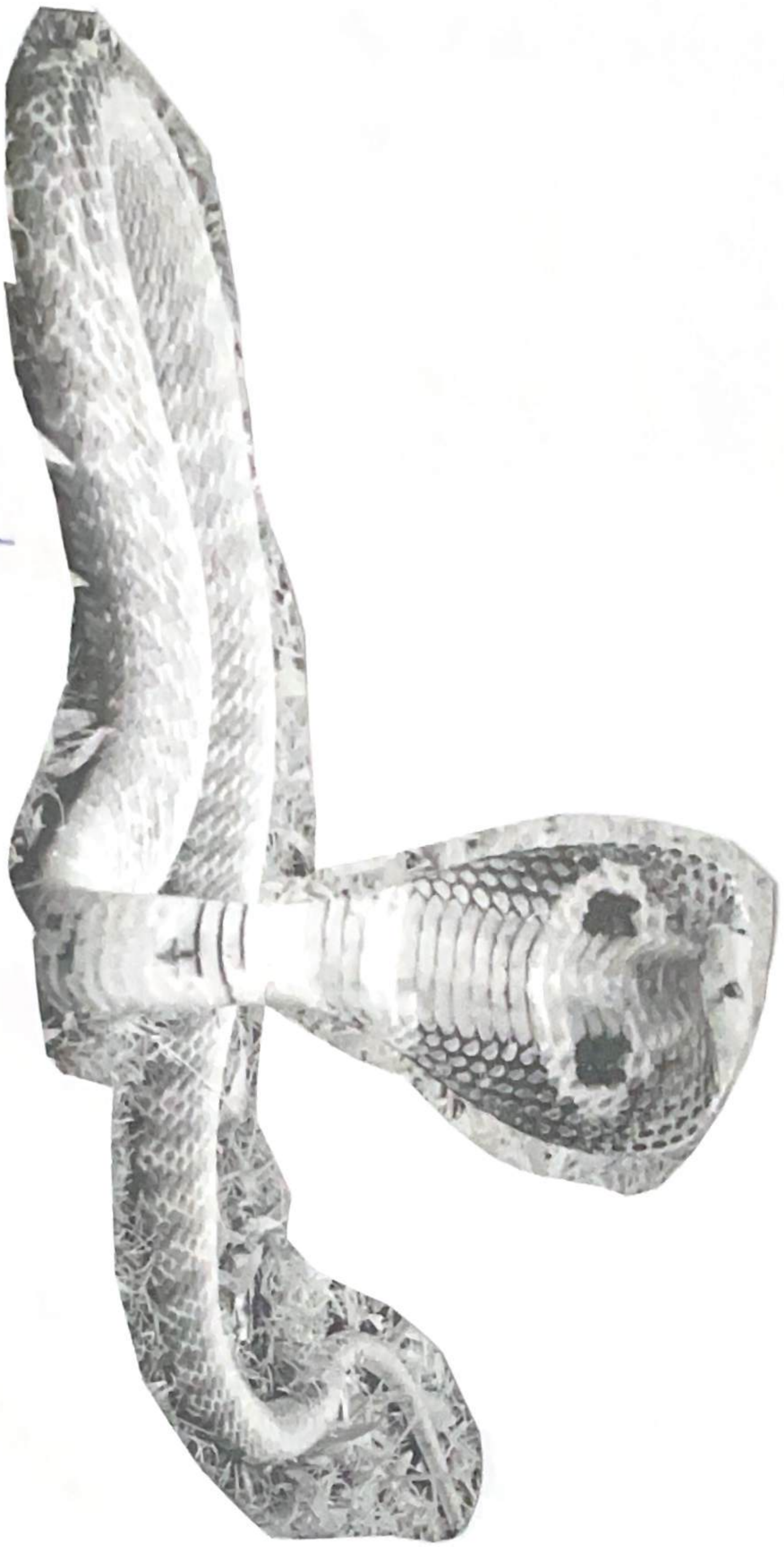

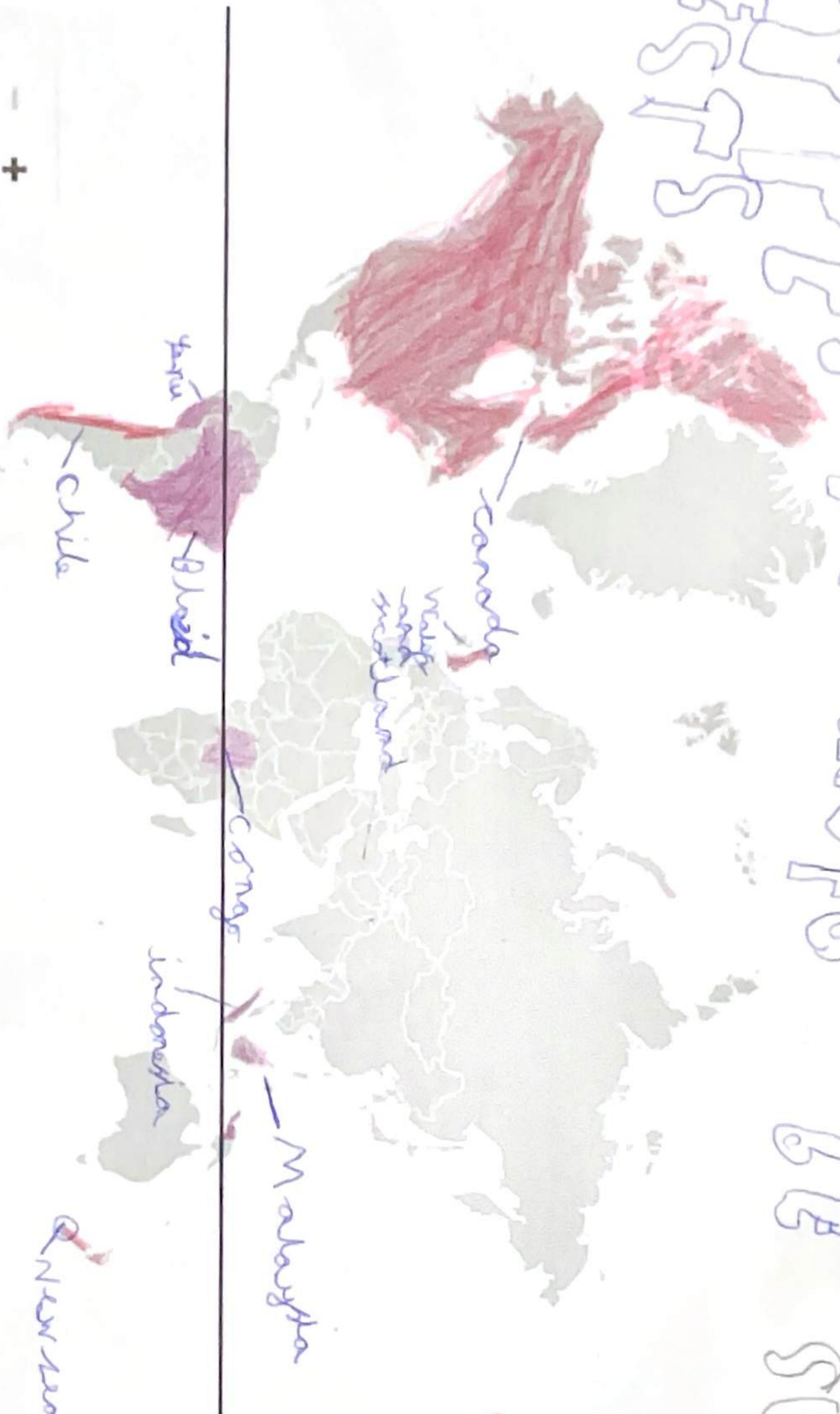
Deforestation

Temperate Rainforests - cooler, near coastlines,

Tropical Rainforests - near equator, hot and wet.

The Amazon rainforest has six times the area of the Amazon rainforest. It is a large ecosystem of approximately 6.7 million square kilometers on the continent of South America which makes it the largest tropical rainforest in the world.

The Amazon rainforest has a humid tropical climate which experiences temperatures 26-30 degrees Celsius most of the time throughout the year.
