## Key Facts:

- Recognise and name 10 instruments in Spanish
- Spell the instruments correctly with their definite article (la, el los) in Spanish
- Learn how to say “I play an instrument” in Spanish
- Know the verb “to play” (tocar).
- Know that the personal pronoun “I” (“yo”) is often dropped in Spanish and just “toco” is used.
