Key Facts:

- Know the nouns and indefinite articles for 8 common pets.
- Ask somebody if they have a pet and reply.
- Say in Spanish what pet we have/if we do not have a pet.
- Say in Spanish our pets name
- Use simple connectives e.g. y (and) or pero (but) to extend sentences.

Possible activities:
