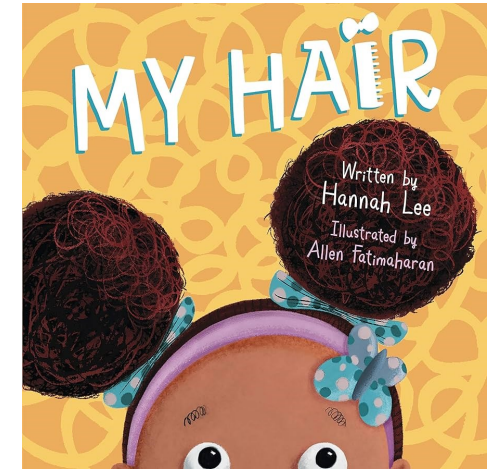


Diversity and Acceptance - My Hair



Early Learning Goals and Key Outcomes:

- Begin to independently demonstrate courtesy and manners.
- Talk about people in their community and from stories appreciate that they may look, speak, dress or act similarly and/or differently from themselves.
- Understand that some places are special to members of their community and share where is special to them.
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.
- Recognise similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.
- See themselves as a valuable individual.
- Begin to show an awareness of stereotypes.



Learning Points:

- Learn that everyone is valuable and unique in their own way.
- Discuss ways to show respect to others, even if they are different.

Key Vocabulary
