- a final oral presentation and/or extended piece of writing detailing where I live and what there is or is not in terms of rooms, at home.

- Vocabulary from the Early Learning units.
- Vocabulary from 'Presenting Myself', 'My Family' and 'Do You Have a Pet?' Intermediate units to be able to present ourselves, talk about our/a family and pets.
