



Nursery Fees Structure (2 Year olds)

At Greenfields Community Primary School, we believe in open communication with all parents/carers and staff. Therefore, the fees set out in this document will assist everyone to understand our charging structure.

Opening times

The nursery has various start time options, as outlined below. The nursery is open for 38 weeks a year in line with the school's term dates. These can be found on our website www.greenfieldscps.kent.sch.uk

Changing provision choices

Once you have agreed your provision choices you will be issued with a contact. Your agreed provision can be only be changed for the start of term 1 (September), term 3 (January) and term 5 (April). If you would like to add additional provision, please contact the school. If you use funded provision then you can only cancel your provision at the end of a term, to ensure we do not claim any additional funding for your child.

Payments

Payments are due weekly and must be made in advance. Payments are made via Schoolcomms, information of this system will be shared by the school. Payments MUST be made by Thursday for the following week. If this is not the case the school will get in contact with you. If payments are continually paid late, this may result in your child's space being terminated.

Pricing

All fees are payable weekly and in advance. Session prices reviewed annually in April each year. Any changes to the current rates will be advised in writing, at least one term in advance. Our fees do not include the cost of outings, celebrations or entertainment that is in addition to our usual session activities. Please note, fees are only payable for the 38 weeks a year the children can attend. There is no charge for any holiday period.

Pricing structure for additional sessions

The price structure below shows the costs for each session. Price is dependent on how many sessions a week your child attends.

Late pick up

If you are late collecting your child at end of a session, a late collection fee will be charged. Should a parent fail to collect their child within 5 minutes of the end of their child's session, they will be charged £10. A further £10 will be charged after another 5 minutes. This will continue for each additional 5 minutes that passes. If a parent is running late, they should contact the school to discuss this as some discretion may be able to be given to the above charges. If a parent is regularly late, this could result in their child's space being terminated.

Closures

Should the nursery be unable to open due to bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances, parents will be refunded for a chargeable session. If you claim funded provision, then please contact the school and we find an appropriate replacement session. Should closure need to take place part way through the day, no refund will be given.

Illness/absence

No refunds or re use of funded hours will be given in the event of a child's absence due to illness, holiday or any other reason.

Free for Two Scheme (FF2)

Some two-year olds may be eligible to receive up to 15 hours funding, known as the Free for Two scheme (FF2) which is subject to meeting certain eligibility criteria. There is a rolling programme for two-year-olds and eligible children can start in a FF2 place at any point during the term, in accordance with the eligibility confirmed start date on the email you will receive once you have applied. Entitlement to a Free Education Place does not offer a guarantee of a place at any one provider or a particular pattern of delivery. For more information or support please speak to the school.
