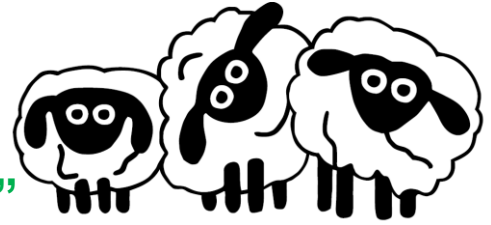

Dear Parents / Carers,

This year, we will continue to use online platforms for their homework. Children will be using the following online platforms to support their learning at home. Please see below for the names of these platforms, where to find them and the minimum expectations for their homework.

### **Numbots/TT Rockstars – a minimum of 5 minutes, 3 times a week**

[www.ttrockstars.com/](http://www.ttrockstars.com/) - Also available to download as an app in the App Store or Google Play or as a website

In **Year 1**, the children will be required to play Numbots a minimum of 5 minutes a time, 3 times a week. This will help with their number recognition, numbers bonds, quick-fire counting and addition and subtraction skills.

In Year 2, the children will be required to play TTRockstars a minimum of 5 minutes a time, 3 times a week. This website helps children develop their times tables by playing quick-fire games in different game modes. The log-in for both numbots and TTRockstars are the same.

### **Reading – a minimum of 15 minutes 3 times a week – 1 weekly post to Seesaw**

We believe that reading is the most vital thing which children can do at home to support and further their learning. Children are expected to read regularly at home (a minimum of three times a week). Once a week, they will need to post on Seesaw about what they have been reading, this could be: a short paragraph, a video/voice recording, a character description etc. Children will be given the opportunity to change their books regularly in school. If books are lost or not returned, a fine will be issued as it is really important that we can continue to have a great stock of books. This homework time is the ideal way to complete reading challenges.

Homework is due in each Monday, children need to ensure that they have reached the minimum expectation of homework beforehand. If, for any reason, your child is unable to access the internet at home, please let your child's class teacher know.

We look forward to seeing your child's progress throughout the year and the support they receive to continue their learning at home.
