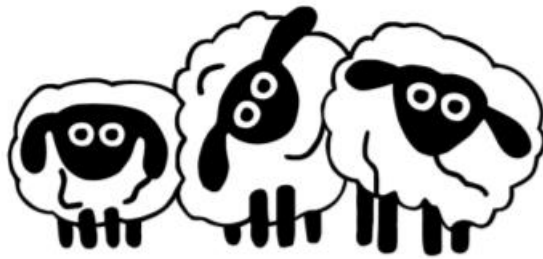


# Uniform policy



**Greenfields**

At Greenfields Community Primary School, it is expected that all children wear school uniform. This includes children in our nursery. We recognise that children come from a variety of different backgrounds and we will ensure that no individual or group is disadvantaged by the implementation of this policy.

Parents will be contacted if their child is not wearing the correct uniform to ascertain reasons for this. In exceptional circumstances – as agreed by the senior leadership team – a uniform pass may be given to a child for a limited period to excuse incorrect uniform. In key stage two (year 3-6), the wearing of incorrect uniform may result in an internal sanction, usually after consultation with parents.

It is preferred, but not essential, that all uniform should have the school logo. These items can be purchased via the school office.

All uniform and bags etc. should be clearly labelled with the child's name.

### Aims

The wearing of school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the individual, as well as in the school
- Promotes an atmosphere of community and belonging
- Endorses and is consistent with our high expectations of high standards
- Is practical and smart
- Encourages people to learn to evaluate others by what they are on the inside, instead of what they are wearing on the outside
- Helps to reduce social exclusion due to appearance
- Is designed with health and safety in mind

### **Children are required to wear:**

Bottle green plain sweatshirt or cardigan with or without the school logo. Children are permitted to wear a bottle green fleece with the school logo. Children can wear a school black Team Greenfields hoodie rather than the bottle green jumper, fleece or cardigan. No other hooded garments are acceptable.

White polo shirt with or without school logo or white tailored shirt

Grey, navy or black tailored trousers or grey, navy or black skirt

Optional Summer Wear: - green striped or checked dresses or grey, navy or black tailored shorts

**PLEASE NOTE: LEGGINGS/JEANS OF ANY COLOUR ARE NOT PERMITTED**

### PE Kit

Black shorts

House coloured plain t-shirt with the school logo.

A plain black tracksuit or Team Greenfields hoodie may be worn for outdoor PE  
Trainers or plimsolls

#### Optional

PE bag with school logo / book bag with school logo  
Baseball cap with school logo  
Woolly hat with school logo  
Fleece coat with school logo  
Reversible raincoat with school logo

#### Shoes

Sensible low heels in plain black, dark brown or navy  
Plain black trainers – with black laces only  
Shoe laces should be the same colour as the shoes

**PLEASE NOTE: Black, dark brown or navy boots may be worn under trousers only**

#### Socks/Tights

Plain white, grey, navy or black

#### Jewellery

It is encouraged that pupils do not wear any jewellery to school. Children are only permitted to wear small stud earrings in pierced ears. Children should be able to remove their stud earrings on request.

**Please note that the school will not take responsibility for any loss or damage caused to any jewellery.**

#### Make up

Children are not permitted to wear any make up at school. This includes nail varnish.

#### Hair

In the interest of health and safety especially during PE lessons and other activities we request that all children with hair below collar length come to school with their hair tied back.

This also helps to reduce the transfer of head lice.

#### Communication Devices

Children are only permitted to bring mobile phones or other communication device in to school in exceptional circumstances – as agreed by a member of the senior leadership team. In these cases, the device must be switched off and handed in to the school office at the beginning of the day. It is the child's responsibility to collect the device at the end of the school day.

### Second Hand Uniform

The school has a large stock of second-hand uniform. If you require second-hand uniform, please contact the school office. There is no charge for second hand uniform but donations can be made.

**We expect all parents whose children attend Greenfields Community Primary School to support the uniform policy. Parents have a duty to ensure their child has the correct uniform and that it is clean and in good repair.**
