Nursery and Year R

Dear parents and carers,

During the late spring/ summer months the SPF factor is medium or high, which places children at risk of sun burn. When your child is at school it is our responsibility to keep them safe, so we ask that your child is provided with a **named sun hat** which we will ensure they wear when outside.

We also ask that you apply **sun cream to your children before** they come into school each day, when you consider it necessary. If your child attends a full day in Nursery, you do not need to bring individual sun creams into school. We will provide sun cream for those children attending full day sessions. The brand that we will be using is Nivea Factor 50 (children's, sensitive). We ask that you provide **£2** towards costs and make payment for this on School Gateway. By paying £2 you have given us permission to apply sun cream to your child.

If your child is allergic to this brand of sun cream then please provide your own (labelled with your child's name). If you do not agree to the use of school sun cream, and do not provide your own, then your child may have to remain indoors for the session, in order to stay safe from the sun.

If your child attends half day sessions in Nursery, we will assume that you have applied sun cream at home and this will be enough to protect them for their session. However, if you wish to provide sun cream in their bag or pay to use ours, then please let a member of the team know.
