LKS2 - Term 4 Events

Dear Parents/Carers,

We wrote to you earlier in the year about the trips and events we had planned for each phase this year. Please see below the details about the events which will be taking place next term.

Botany and Viking Bay - Beach Trip

To enhance the learning of our Geography topic on Coasts, LKS2 will be visiting Viking Bay and Botany Bay. During the trip, we will explore real coastal landscapes, including cliffs, bays and beaches, and observe how the sea shapes the land through erosion. We will also enjoy time at the seaside by taking part in activities such as a visit to the arcades. We will also get the chance to enjoy an ice cream, helping us to understand how coastal areas are used for leisure and tourism. This visit will deepen the children's understanding of how coasts are formed, how they change over time, and why they are important.

We will be traveling by the school minibuses to Botany and Viking Bay. We aim to leave school promptly at 9:00am so all children should be in school at 8:45am on the day of their trip for registration. They will require a packed lunch and a drink in a bag which they can carry. They will also require a coat and comfortable footwear. We aim to return to school by 3:15pm.

The children can bring a maximum of £10 spending money in a named envelope or a purse/wallet if they wish.
